5	Identify and promote good practice within the industry, including to non members.			
6	Organise industry working groups (not led by HSE) to set and publish industry standards. Monitor the effective implementation of the industry standards.			
7	Proactively identify new or developing risks within the industry. Lead the preparation and dissemination of solutions. Monitor the effectiveness and implementation of solutions.			
8	Set overall output targets for the industry or member companies (e.g. 10% less RIDDORs by xx)			
9	Require commitment from member companies to set input targets as a requirement of membership (e.g. every company to do xx by yy)			
10	Encourage use of internal audit schemes and subsequent bench marking			
11	Encourage use of H&S climate tools and subsequent bench marking			
12	Encourage development of supply chain initiatives			
13	Encourage occupational health/disease initiatives within the industry.			
14	Encourage the development and use of leading occupational health indicators and metrics for long latency diseases.			
15	Open up some materials/facilities from the H&S scheme to non-members, preferably without charge, as both an enticement to membership and as a way of improving standards in non-member companies			
16	Open up all the materials/facilities from the H&S scheme to non-members, or offer reasonably priced health and safety consultancy services to non-member companies based on these materials
